He also discussed statistics and shared real-life examples of road accidents to emphasize the life-or-death consequences of ignoring road safety measures. His session was well-received, and he encouraged everyone to be proactive in promoting road safety in their communities.

The seminar was followed by a unique and creative activity, a Nukkad Natak (Role play), performed by students from Vallabh Ashram School. The role play conveyed powerful messages about the importance of adhering to traffic rules, including the use of helmets while riding motorcycles, following pedestrian signals, and avoiding distracted driving. The students acted out common road safety scenarios, dramatizing both the consequences of unsafe practices and the positive impact of following safety guidelines. Their engaging performance captivated the audience and made the messages more memorable.





