



HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PROGRAM


The program commenced with a Lamp Lighting & Prayer

A short virtual presentation was shown to commemorate her contributions.




Cultural & Festival Presentations

Onam: Importance explained by Ms. Ester (4th Sem. B.Sc. Nursing).


Eid-e-Milad: Significance highlighted by Ms. Rashiya Shaikh (5th Sem. B.Sc. Nursing).

Vote of Thanks


Ms. Jiya Mishra (5th Sem. B.Sc. Nursing) expressed gratitude to all dignitaries, faculty, and students.
